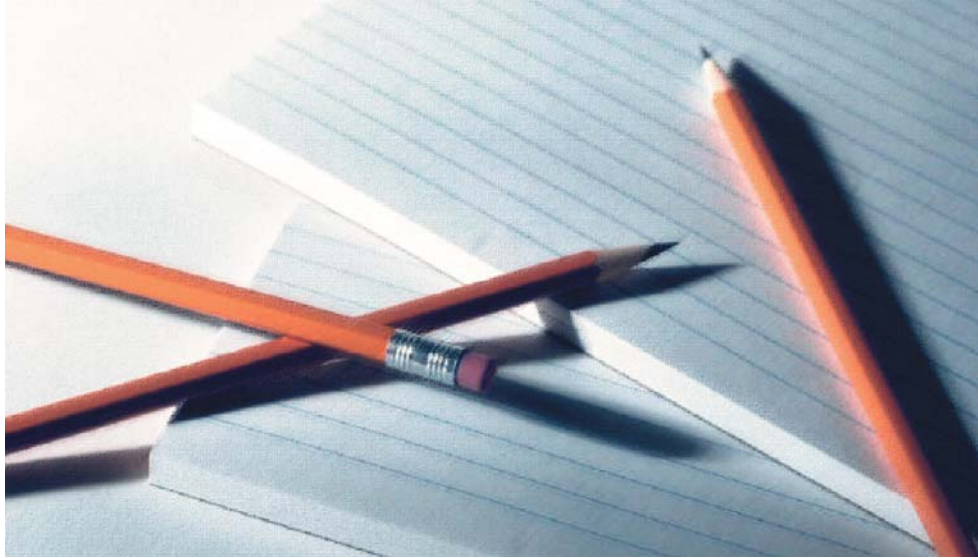

Part 3 also serves as a one day re-certification for individuals already certified as Behavior Intervention Case Manager through the Tulare County SELPA.
