

Local Plan Working Committees

- A. Working Committees shall be established for the following purposes:
 - 1. To propose SELPA-wide policies for consideration by the Directors of Special Education Committee and the Superintendents Governance Committee.
 - 2. To recommend solutions for problems arising within the SELPA in the areas of the Committees' concern.
 - 3. To provide input on current needs of the SELPA LEAs to the SELPA Administrator for appropriate action.

- B. The following are established as ad hoc committees:
 - 1. Transportation Committee
 - 2. Fiscal Committee
 - 3. Special Education Information System (SEIS) Committee
 - 4. Staff Development Committee
 - 5. Technology Committee

- C. Committee membership shall be representative of Tulare County and include, as much as possible, representation from small, medium and large school districts.

Committee membership on any one Committee shall not exceed eleven (11).

The committee chairperson shall be selected by the committee.

The terms of committee members will be reviewed annually.

All working Committees are advisory in nature.

These Working Committees and other ad hoc committees report through the Directors of Special Education Committee to the SELPA Administrator and the Superintendents Governance Committee as appropriate. The activity and contribution of each of the committee participants promotes the successful implementation of the Tulare County/District Local Plan for Special Education.
