***Individualized Education Program –Electronic
Recording***

The Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA), the local education agency (LEA), and the parent/guardian have the right to electronically record the proceedings of Individualized Education Program (IEP) meetings. The notice of parental/guardian rights provided with the student's Assessment Plan at each IEP Team meeting shall include these parent/guardian rights.

The parent/guardian, District, SELPA, or Tulare County Office of Education shall notify the members of the IEP Team of their intent to record a meeting at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. With sufficient notice, a parent/guardian's right to audio record an IEP team meeting is absolute. It is recommended that if a parent/guardian audio record's an IEP team meeting that the District also record the meeting.

If the District, SELPA, or County Office initiates the notice of intent to record a meeting and the parent/guardian objects or refuses to attend the meeting because it will be electronically recorded, then the meeting shall not be recorded on a recording device.
