Levels of Confidentiality – Student Records

The following levels of confidentiality shall be established for the purpose of collecting and distributing needed information about a particular student's functioning or performance level:

- A. Directory Information – **Level I** – (Basic identifying data)
 - 1. Basic ID Data
 - 2. Academic Achievement
 - 3. Attendance Data
 - 4. Health Data

- B. Student Group Information – **Level II** – (Verified group data – generally gathered by schools about a particular student's functioning or performance level.)
 - 1. Student Achievement Test Data
 - 2. Student IQ and Aptitude Tests
 - 3. Medical History
 - 4. Administrative Data
 - 5. Individualized Education Program Documents

- C. Student Personal Information – **Level III** – (Information, tentative in nature, important to an individualized education program for a particular period of time.)
 - 1. Personality Tests and Psychological Interpretations
 - 2. Reports of Professionals
 - 3. Reports of Other Agencies
 - 4. Anecdotal Records
